

How to Reach CBIP Centre of Excellence, Plot No.21, Sector-32, Gurgaon

Gurgaon, is the second largest city in the Indian state of Haryana and is a part of the National Capital Region (NCR). It is about 15 kilometers from IGI Airport, New Delhi. Gurgaon is well connected to Delhi via an expressway (NH8 highway) and Delhi Metro. For going to **CBIP Centre of Excellence** for any of the following options. You have to enter through Exit 10 from main Delhi-Jaipur highway Road, taking immediate left turn. Then again take first left turn. The Centre is the last building on this road on left side.

- **From New Delhi Railway Station**

- > Take metro (Yellow Line) from New Delhi station and drop at Huda metro station.

CBIP Centre of Excellence is about 5 KM from this station.

- > Take Auto (which are available even on sharing basis) from Huda metro station to CBIP Centre of Excellence.

- **From Old Delhi Railway Station**

- > Take metro (yellow line) from Chandi Chowk, Which is at walking distance from Old Delhi Railway Station and drop at Huda metro station.

CBIP Centre of Excellence is about 5 KM from this station.

- > Take Auto (which are available even on sharing basis) from Huda metro station to CBIP Centre of Excellence.

- **From Nizamuddin Railway Station**

- > Take Haryana Roadways Bus from Sarai Kaale Khan Bus stand which is at walking distance from Nizamuddin Railway Station and drop at IFFCO Chowk.

CBIP Centre of Excellence is about 5 KM from this Bus stop.

- > Take Auto (which are available even on sharing basis) from IFFCO Chowk to CBIP Centre of Excellence.

- **From ISBT, Mori Gate, New Delhi**

- > Take Metro from Kashmeri Gate Metro Station (Yellow Line) and drop at Huda metro station.

CBIP Centre of Excellence is about 5 KM from this Bus stop.

- > Take Auto (which are available even on sharing basis) from Huda metro station to CBIP Centre of Excellence.

- **From IGI Airport**

- > It is convenient to take direct taxi from IGI air port to CBIP Centre of Excellence it is about 15 Km from the IGI Airport.
