



Conferences

Awards

- CBIP in the past has presented number of awards in the form of gold medals, certificates of merit, citations, cash awards and other awards to recognize outstanding contributions in the areas of research, engineering, scientific and managerial aspects so as to promote professional excellence in the fields of water resources, energy and allied disciplines to individuals and institutions.
- The CBIP awards have been presented by Dr. Zakir Hussain, Shri V.V. Giri, Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru, Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri, Smt. Indira Gandhi and Shri Rajiv Gandhi and other dignitaries.
- One of the awards was a 22 ct. Gold Medal, weighing between 2-3 tolas, and made at a mint in Kolkata. The first recipient of this coveted Gold Medal was Shri V. Ganesh Iyer of Mysore Engineering Research Station in 1953 for his inventions of 'Volute Siphons'.
- The prominent recipients of CBIP awards include Dr. N. Tata Rao (Chairman, APSEB), Shri S.N. Roy (Chairman, CEA), Dr. Y.K. Murthy (Chairman, CWC), Shri S.K. Banerjee (Chairman, CGWB), Shri C.C. Patel and Shri M.G. Padhye (Secretaries to GOI, Ministry of Irrigation).
