INTRODUCTION

Today the use of geosynthetics is increasingly being accepted as construction material in different fields of civil engineering not only in developed countries but also in the developing countries like ours. Geosynthetics are now being increasingly used the world over for every conceivable application in civil engineering, namely, construction of dam, embankments, canals, approach roads, runways, railway embankments, retaining walls, slope protection works, drainage works, river training works, seepage control, etc. due to their inherent qualities. Its use in India though is picking up, is not anywhere close to recognitions. This is due to limited awareness of the utilities of this material and development taking place in its use.

The Ministry of Textiles, Government of India, formulated a scheme for promoting Usage of Geotechnical Textiles in North East Region (NER) in order to capitalize on the benefits of Geotechnical Textiles in difficult terrain of North Eastern Region of India.

The scheme envisages use of Geotextiles on pilot basis for demonstration and proving efficacy in areas of Road and infrastructure building, Slope and hill protection and Water Reservoirs in North Eastern States.

In the year 1985, the Central Board of Irrigation and Power (CBIP) as part of its technology forecasting activities identified geosynthetics as important and relevant to India's need for infrastructure development, and formed the Indian Chapter of International Geosynthetics Society (IGS). The Secretariat of the Indian Chapter is at CBIP.

The present Seminar is being organized by the CBIP, in association with Indian Chapter of IGS, with the support of the office of the Textile Commissioner, to promote the objectives of the scheme for promoting Usage of Geotechnical Textiles in North East Region (NER).
