INTRODUCTION

India has set a visionary target to achieve net zero emissions by 2070, with significant milestones in renewable energy integration along the way. With increasing penetration of solar and wind, the power system faces new challenges in grid balancing, peak demand management, and maintaining frequency stability. In this context, Pumped Storage Projects (PSPs) are being widely recognized as the most reliable, mature, and scalable energy storage technology.

Recognizing the critical role PSPs will play in the future power mix, the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) and THDC India Ltd. in association with NTPC, with the support of CBIP & INCOLD, are jointly organizing a One-Day Brainstorming session. The aim is to foster dialogue and collaboration among policymakers, developers, technical experts, state utilities, and regulatory authorities.

This session will focus on:

- · Policy and statutory frameworks
- Environmental and forest clearances
- · Design and constructional challenges
- · Geological and material considerations
