
TRAINING ON SMART METERING (For Power Professionals)

This new scheme was introduced by the government in July 2017 with the objectives of improving the financial and operational efficiencies of distribution companies, including reducing the aggregate technical and commercial losses to 12-15% by the end of its target timeline.

Smart metering offers a plethora of benefits including real-time monitoring, tamper detection, and automated billing, which can greatly curb electricity loss. The ability to measure electricity consumption and transmit that data in real time to utility companies eliminates the need for manual meter readings, reducing the risk of human error and the potential for tampering. Improving the operational efficiency, profitability and cost effectiveness of power distribution companies in India calls for the rapid adoption of smart metering technology.

India has currently installed approx. 10 million smart meters. It is still in the nascent stage of rolling out this technology to all households in the country, providing immense growth potential for solutions offering interoperability.

Smart metering solutions are also a game-changer for ambitious renewable energy projects as they will ensure accuracy and transparency in how electricity is managed, consumed, and monitored, paving the way for a more efficient and resilient power grid.
