


Dam Rehabilitation & Improvement Project (Rajasthan State)

- Rajasthan has 211 large dam out of which most of are for storing irrigation & drinking water, contribute to sustaining the livelihoods and food security. Average age of large dam in Rajasthan is 56 years. Oldest dam in Rajasthan is Udai Sagar built in the year 1585 (434 year old).
- Preliminary Rs.965.65 Cr.(Rs.503.02for II Phase+ Rs. 462.63 Cr.) has been approved by Ministry of Jal Shakti for Rajasthan state.
- Tenders of about Rs.162 Cr. for Rehabilitation & Improvement Works of 08 Dams (Bisalpur, Chhapi, Jawai, Sukli Selwara, Mahi, Gambhiri, Matrikundia and Som Kamla Amba Dam) have been floated. Rajasthan State is leading State in terms of preparatory activities for DRIP phase-II.
- Project will be in two phases with total duration of 10 years. Each Phase is of 06 years with 02 years overlapping period.
- Primarily 50 dams are selected for DRIP.

 Rehabilitation and Management Planning for Dams and Associated Appurtenances, Dam Safety Institutional Strengthening, Risk-informed Asset Management and Innovative Financing for Sustainable Operation and Maintenance of Dams & Project Management.
